Workshop Notes

April 20: Acrylic Floral Wreath w/ Patte Kayne

Mixing colors for painting florals can be a lot of fun. Knowing how to mix colors from the basics is very helpful to achieve a wider range of values. Patte will be providing lots of color mixing tips during this workshop!

Surface:

- 11"x14" Canvas or Cradled Panel or surface of your choice. Pattern can be resized as needed.
- **Surface should be base-coated with shale green, oyster beige, or other light color prior to class.**

Paint:

- Good primary and secondary colors: red, yellow, blue, green, orange, purple.
- Earth colors: raw sienna, burnt umber, raw umber.
- Light buttermilk (warm white), soft black (warm black)

Suggested Paint Colors:

| Cool Colors | Warm Colors | Earth Colors |
|------------------|------------------|------------------|
| Dioxazine Purple | Citron Green | Burnt Umber |
| Red Violet | Hansa Yellow | Raw Sienna |
| Plantation Pine | Alizarin Crimson | Raw Umber |
| Sap Green | | Light Buttermilk |
| Ultramarine Blue | | Soft Black |

Brushes:

- Liner, Round #3 or #4, Small Filbert, #12 Flat or Angle Shader (5/8" or 3/4") with a good chisel edge.

Other Supplies:

- Small palette knife
- Wet palette (if you have one)
- Palette paper (grey is recommended)
- Black & White graphite paper
- Tracing paper
- Black fine tip marker
- Pencil
- Paper towels, Water basin
